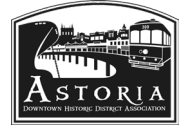

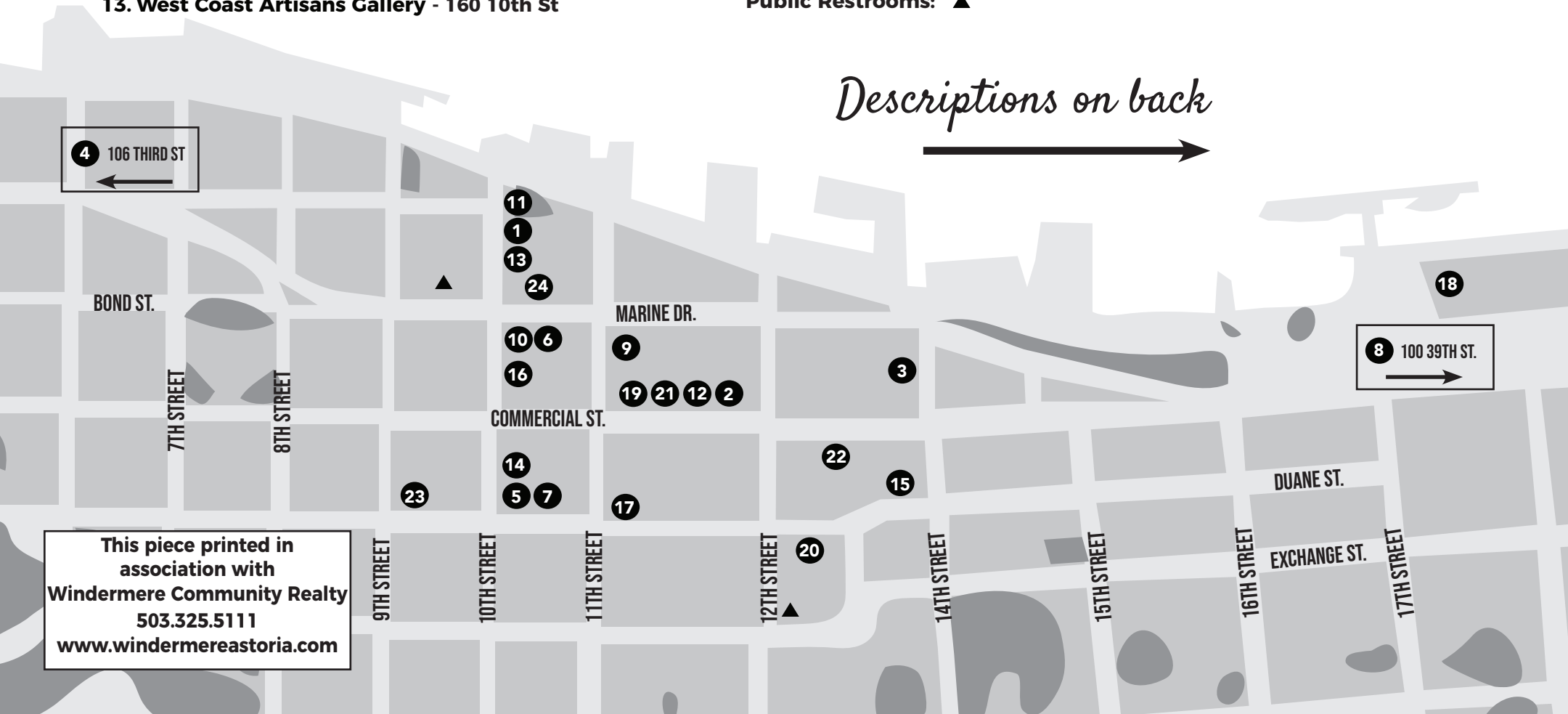

## 1. Angi D Wildt Gallery Zen of Sound & Art

Devi Wind will perform in the gallery from 4 to 6 PM. Maria Kadi plays Native American style wooden flutes, bamboo and alto concert flute. Kathleen Callon plays the harmonium. Enjoy the zen of sound and art. Twenty-three artists are represented.

## 2. ARTstoria Gallery Spring Forward!

ARTstoria celebrates the coming of spring with color and nature, flow and exploration. Visitors receive a glimpse of downtown historical architecture when entering this unique 1923 building. It's worth climbing the stairs! Paintings, journals, and home decor by artist/owner Connie Dillon. Open 2:00-7:00.

## 5. Astoria Visual Arts Uprooted - Anna Kaufman

Astorian Anna Kaufman, a recent graduate of Vassar College, transports viewers into a multi-sensory, interactive experience into the ongoing social and political battle that often divides the population of Clatsop County—the environmental and ecological impact of clear cutting old growth forests.

## 6. Cambium Gallery Collective Energy

Cambium Gallery is excited to welcome the collaborative art experience by abstract artist Kirista Trask and sound healer Benery titled Collective Energy. Collective Energy is part sound bath, a deeply-immersive, full-body listening experience that intentionally uses sound to invite gentle yet powerful therapeutic and restorative processes, and part art performance. The work created for Collective Energy will be recorded and then installed for further exploration throughout March. Collective Energy starts at 3:30 pm March 11.

## 7. Brumfield Gallery Doug Whitfield

Doug Whitfield is fascinated with the concept of individual perception of reality, dreams and alternative realities. His approach to painting is instinctive, engaged and engaging. There is whimsy combined with real-world grit in the subject matter. In his dancing couples and shortened figures he questions the notions of loveliness and the grotesque - creating endearing protagonists that fall outside the norms of accepted beauty.

## 8. Gallery on Pier 39 A Collection of Daydreams

Dianne Valenzuela, of Daydreamn D Art, is a self-taught mixed media artist that draws inspiration from nature, namely fungi, and music. You can find a mix of framed original watercolor and pen illustrations and giclee prints on display. Watch as Dianne paints the Pier 39 spring display from 12-4pm.

## 9. Imogen Gallery Kim Hamblin Outskirts of Biophilia

We welcome back Kim Hamblin and her complex hand cut paper assemblages. Known for her intricate compositions on wood panel, created with paper, acrylic paint, steel nails and an X-Acto knife, Hamblin brings a new series titled "Outskirts of Biophilia". Within this series she takes a deeper consideration into the relationship between humankind and the wild, still drawing inspiration from her love of biology, botany and anatomy. Stop by and meet Kim, she'll be at the gallery 5- 7 pm. The exhibition will remain on view through April 3.

## 10. KALA Then There, Here Now

Then There, Here Now, is an exhibition with an eclectic mix of works created by Astoria artist Rachel Siegel. The exhibit includes works with themes of time & place; environment, landscape, home & people; embodiment & disembodiment. This micro retrospective features works of mixed media, collage, digital photography, illustrations, and installation.

## 11. Paul Polson Studio Gallery Paintings by Paul Polson

## 12. RiverSea Gallery L McDonald's Ethereal Figure Painting

Glimpses is a solo exhibition of expressionist figure paintings by Portland artist L McDonald, who has been fascinated with the human form and figure through three decades of making art. She paints ethereal figures immersed in abstracted surroundings, applying delicate layers of color to build sensitive yet powerful compositions. Recurrent themes of close relationships and contemplative solitude appear in McDonald's work. She paints intuitively, and her figures are imperfect by choice. She embraces awkwardness and ambiguity, which she sees as a profound part of the human experience. Artist Reception: 5:00–8:00.

## 13. West Coast Artisans Gallery PNW in Black and White

Kim Rose Adams is our newest local photographer. Kim has a love for the Northwest Coast, especially the basalt rock formations and dramatic cliffs, creating a series of black and white photos that show how the past shores up to the present. Through exploration and observation of the natural world, she enjoys making deeper connections by learning the meanings of cultural objects and understanding the earth from a naturalistic perspective.

## 14. Astoria Studio Collective Writer's Guild Book Fair

The Writer's Guild is sponsoring a Pop-Up Authors' Fair in The Commons at the Astoria Studio Collective.
